The questions of how and why we have evolved during the last millions of years to be what we are today are strongly connected to our reproductive success. During the course of human evolution, our biology and, especially, many of the so called "human" behaviors have changed gradually.

Pregnancy, breastfeeding, growing up, feeding, rearing of our children, etc., are some of the changes that have made us different from our next primate relatives. The study of those important moments for the hominins helps us to understand the particular evolving trail of our species.
