E. EXAMINATION PHASE

The maximum score for this phase shall be 60 points. It shall be eliminatory.

The candidate shall give an oral presentation in English on the topic: "Present and future of research in Palaeoproteomics in human evolutionary studies", which shall be an exposition of the potential of paleoproteomics for studies of human evolution, and their own contributions and interests for the development of the discipline. The duration of the presentation shall be at most 30 minutes, and it may be followed by questions from the Selection Committee to elicit further the candidate's knowledge with regard to the position.

The points evaluated shall be technical knowledge of the subject, the coherence and uniqueness of its content, the capacity of the candidate to develop the methods and techniques to be used in the research, linguistic competence, and the fit of the presentation to the strategic and scientific mission and vision of the Center.

Candidates will be invited by email and/or regular mail assigning the date and time for this examination, which is expected to take place during the week of May 27th, 2024.

This phase shall last at most 60 minutes.

A minimum score of 30 points is required to pass this phase.
