#### A.3. General indicators of the scientific production quality

On 2/2/2017 the Consolidated Research Unit of Castilla y León number UIC 182 was recognized, directed by Manuel Santonja Gómez, recognizing the director, in accordance with the rules of the call, 5 *sexenios* of research (1981-2011).

In the last 10 years I have directed 6 doctoral theses, 4 presented (rated with “sobresaliente cum laude”) and 2 in progress.

Google Scholar (search 3/08/2018): total citations: 2427; h-index: 24; i10: 67. More than 200 papers published, 32 of them in Q1 journals according to Scimago JR.

### Part B. FREE SUMMARY OF THE CURRICULUM

The research activity of the last 10 years has been focused on the Paleolithic of the Iberian Peninsula and the Olduvai Gorge (Tanzania). Previously, in the first phase of the research activity he was part of the research team of El Aculadero (Cádiz), performing at the Bordeaux University the study of the lithic industry with Professor François Bordes. He has directed research in the most prominent Spanish Palaeolithic sites, such as Pinedo (Toledo) in 1974-76; Áridos (Madrid) in 1976; La Maya I (Salamanca) in 1976-79 and 1988; El Sartalejo (Cáceres) in 1982-3; Ambrona and Torralba (Soria), in 1990-2006 and 2013-16; Cuesta de la Bajada (Teruel), in 1990-1994 and 1999-2015; Puente Pino (Toledo), in 2001-2012; Porto Maior and Gándaras de Budiño (Pontevedra), in 2011-2015 and 2018, or El Sotillo (Ciudad Real) in 2017-2018. Since 2009 he has been part of the scientific team of TOPPP (The Olduvai Paleoanthropology and Paleoecology Project), dealing with the research of Acheulean and, among others, the TK site digging (Olduvai, Bed II).

Middle Palaeolithic bone assemblages" (Neuwied, Germany, 1995) and "Coping with deteriorating Climate (30-20 Kyr bp)" (Dolní-Vestonice, Czech Republic, 1995), XIII International Congress of Prehistoric and Protohistoric Sciences (Forlì, Italy, 1996), First International Congress "The World of Elephants" (Rome, Italy, 2001).

Author of 8 scientific monographs on prehistory and Spanish archeology and editor of 15 others. He has collaborated in sixty books, writing 75 chapters. Author of more than a hundred articles in quality journals, both Spanish and from other countries (Analecta Praehistorica Leidense, Bulletin of the Societe Prehistorique Française, Current Anthropology, Jahrbuch des Römisch-Germanischen Zentralmuseum, Journal of World Prehistory, Portugal, Quaternary International, Journal of Archaeological Science, Plos One, Journal of Quaternary Science, Quaternary Science Review, Quaternary Geochronology, Boreas, O Arqueologo Português, British Archaeological Reports, Trabajos de Prehistoria, Zephyrus etc.), more than 40 communications in conference proceedings and of other 35 abstracts and several notes. He belongs to the editorial boards of Zephyrus (University of Salamanca), Origini (University of Rome), Cuadernos de Prehistoria y Arqueología (Autonomous University of Madrid) and ArkeoGazte (Association of young researchers in prehistoric and historical Archeology) journals. Previously he was part of the Complutum –Universidad Complutense de Madrid- (2003-2010), Cuaternario y Geomorfología (1993-2008), Salamanca. Revista Provincial de Estudios (1991-2005) and BSAA -Universidad de Valladolid- (2005-2018).

He has worked at the Complutense University of Madrid (Assistant Professor, 1974-1975); Museo Arqueológico Nacional, Madrid (contracted and interim Curator, 1975 and 1976); Museo de Lleida (Director, 1976-1977); Museo de Palencia (Director, 1977-1978); Museo de Salamanca (Director, 1978-2003) and Museo Arqueológico Regional of Madrid (Conservator and Adviser of the Direction, 2003-2009).
